AuctionBidding has begun on the 2013 AMHA/World Morgan Futurity Stallion Service Auction! Go to 2013 Stallion Service Auction to see this year's roster. You'll find new stallions, returning stallions, and some world champions just crowned at the 2012 Grand National! Also offered this year is the December 2013 cover of The Morgan Horse magazine, one of the most widely read issues of the year. Online bidding will close on February 21, 2013 at 6 p.m. PST (9 p.m. EST). Telephone bids will be accepted throughout the day of February 23, 2013 until 7 p.m. PST. Bidding will continue on the stallions with the Top 10 bid "amounts" on February 23, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. PST during the live stallion service auction, held at The Benson Hotel in Portland, Oregon. In return for your sponsorship you can have a professionally-designed banner ad for your farm, horse for sale, or business that will rotate on the website both prior to, and during, the live auction.

The goal of the NYSSA is to raise as much money as possible though the sale of donated breeding contracts. 2013 NEW YORK MORGAN STALLION SERVICE AUCTION A Successful Grand National For Arbordale Riding Academy By Andrea Whiting

> Arbordale Riding Academy of Odessa, FL was burning up the winner's circle at shows all year prior to making the long trek to Oklahoma City this past October. In only their second year attending the Morgan Grand National and World Championship show, their successful 2012 streak continued.

Kaley Felberg and her horse, Mapleton True North (White Rock's Calliope x Kendall Kara Lee) marched around the coliseum showing off his trademark "chesspeice" headset and incredible powerful road trot in the Saddle Seat Road Hack Finals. It was no surprise when Kaley and "Carlos" were called to the winners circle for the National Championship win to bring the tri-color ribbon, plaque and blue cooler back to Florida.

Anissa Jessee showed the 2012 season as only a seven year old; this tiny tot and her talented horse Rare Treasure (Noble Flaire x Tedwin In Tempo) turned a lot of heads and earned a lot of fans at Nationals. They showed in the Walk/Trot Classic division and in the Grand National Pleasure class for riders 9 and under they left the ring with an 8th place ribbon and had a better go in the class for riders II and under to finish with a 9th place World Champion ribbon. In their equitation classes they shone brilliantly! This little girl and her bold horse left the Performance Arena in the 9 and under Grand National class with a 3rd place ribbon and a first place vote from one of the judges. In the 11 and under World Championship they again scored another first place vote and left the ring with a 7th place World Championship ribbon.

Young Cassidy Gill became a proud new horse owner in 2012 when her parents bought her Pomp And Circumstance (Born To Boogle x Sweetheart's Parade). This young team showed in the Walk/Trot Hunter division. They had brilliant rides in the Grand National classes for riders 8 and under with 4th place ribbons in both their pleasure and equitation classes. In their very large 11 and under championship, they trotted out of the ring with a 9th place in the World Championship Pleasure class.

Emma Banks also showed Pomp And Circumstance in the Junior Exhibitor hunter classes. In the 12 and under Grand National class they had an outstanding ride for a 4th place ribbon and then showed back in the World Championship for riders 13 and under and earned a very respectable 9th place in some very strong competition.

We also had riders participate in the Junior Judging competition and Arbordale students Jennifer Wayman won first place in the senior division and Lauren Gill won third place in the junior division. All in all we had a fun and fantastic time in Oklahoma City and we at Arbordale Riding Academy are very happy to have brought such great ribbons home to Florida. Our modest training and riding program is proud to have had such a successful 2012 season in general and we are eagerly anticipating what the 2013 season will bring! We wish all of our FMHA friends a Merry Christmas and a happy and prosperous New Year!

### Coat Color Testing is Available

There are five separate tests that the Veterinary Genetics Lab can run that will tell you what coat color genetics your horse has. Most coat colors can be determined by physical appearance however, genetic testing can tell you what coat color genetics your horse possesses that are not apparent by visual inspection. For example, a black horse appears black, but will it produce black offspring or will they be bay? Coat color testing can tell you the answer!
