RECENT USEF FEE CHANGES

Starting next year, the US Equestrian Membership fee will increase from \$55 to \$80. Separately, the Drugs 8 Medications fee per horse, per show will increase to \$15. Sadly, this increase is necessary to fund the battle against cheating on the field of play and to defend the findings of the Hearing Committee in the court room. Another member change starting next year is that we will be moving to an anniversary membership model. This means that no matter when someone joins, they will enjoy a full 12-month membership.






