Donated in 1984 by Alicia and Ron Davis of Raindrop Farm to honor Great Oaks Ashmon, known to his friends as Blondie, was a multi-champion pleasure horse. His many wins included both the Amateur and Open Championships at the Citrus Cup



- 1. USEF Membership Statement: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes
- 2. USEF Fees: Every horse in this competition shall pay a \$15.00 fee for Drugs and Medication and an \$8.00 fee for USEF.
- 3. USEF Rules: EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
- 4. Arenas: Arenas have fiber or clay base footing. Arena measurements— WEC Grand Arena: 320' x 400; Indoor 1 171' x 530', Indoor 4: 192' x 525' and Hunter 3 & 4 175' x 300'.
- 5. Show Office: The Show Office will open on Tuesday April 22. Office hours will be posted on the office door.
- 6. Arrival Time: Stalls will be available Monday April 21 Horses may arrive early Sunday April 20 with additional fee and arrangements through Alicia. All stalls have doors and are permanent concrete stalls with stable comfort mattress systems and fans in a climate controlled barn, 11'X11'. Stalls may not be occupied by more than one horse at a time. Damage: Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any damage to their stalls on the premises. Do not put nails in the sidewalls. Stalls must be vacated in their original condition. Stalls may not be structurally altered in any way. All damages that WEC charges Citrus Cup Horse Show will be billed back to the trainer. This charge will automatically be added to your final invoice through the horse show office. Charges from WEC billed to Citrus Cup for the removal of lumber or other items used for decorating purposes will be billed to the trainer following the show.
- 7. Campers, RV Slips, Golf Carts: Reserve only through World Equestrian Center at www.worldequestriancenter.com. Golf Carts—World Equestrian Center Rent Golf Carts Today! (wecgolfcarts.com) RV Rentals—World Equestrian Center—Ocala (windsurfercrs.com). Links available on our website at www.FMHA.net under Citrus Cup.
- 8. Dogs/Animals Leash Requirements: Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while on the property. Any dog that is deemed aggressive by WEC Staff or security will be asked to be removed from the property or put away in the owner's residence. No dogs are allowed in working arenas at any time during the week of Citrus Cup.
- 9. Entries: Pre Entries must be postmarked, completed on line or emailed by April 1, 2025. No dressage or Trail entries accepted after April 1,2025 Entries postmarked after that date will be charged an additional \$50.00 per horse post entry fee. Entries must be accompanied by full payment in order to be processed. Open checks mailed in with entries are acceptable. Entries must be properly made on the official entry form.



10. Fees:

Stall Fee	\$250.00 per stall
Office Fee	\$50.00 per horse
USEF D/M Fee	\$23.00 per horse
Early move in fee (before Monday April 21)	\$35 per stall per day
Post Entry Fee	. \$50.00 per horse if entered after 4/1/2025.

- 11. Feed and Bedding: All feed and bedding must be ordered through StallInfo.net at least 24 hours in advance to guarantee delivery prior to arrival. No outside shavings deliveries permitted.
- 12. Health Requirements: WEC requires a 14-day health certificate or statement of health ,including in-state horses. Florida regulations require that all equine be covered by official interstate health certificates or statement of health issued by a licensed veterinarian, showing that the animals are free from any symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease. The certificate shall include the name of the owner and address, destination in Florida, number of horses examined, the name, registration number (s), if any, tattoo, if any, sex, age, rectal temperature, color and markings of each animal listed. Health certificates will become void after 30 days from issue. Health certificates must show animals to be negative to an equine infectious anemia test within the past 12 months. Date of test and approved laboratory must be shown on health certificate. Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of the vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the caser of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request from Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperatures taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward or technical delegate when requested. 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.
- 13. The age for Junior Exhibitors and Masters will be based on their age as of December 1, 2024.
- 14. Sharps Containers: Sharps Containers (USEFGR1210.4) Competition Management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses.



15. Motorized Vehicle Statement: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.


The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- 16. Officials: In the event that due to illness or failure of a show official to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a Show Official. No one shall approach or contact a Judge with regard to a decision unless they first obtain permission from the Show Steward who may arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.
- 17. PA System: Due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA System and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible to have his horse at the gate at the prescribed time. While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA System, no refund will be made, section changed, or protest upheld on the basis of a PA failure.
- 18. Refunds: All fees (except to the Show Secretary) will be returned with a signed and dated Doctor or Veterinarian's Certificate on letterhead. All refunds will be mailed within 30 days following the show.
- 19. Registration/Membership Requirements: Copies of Registration papers showing proof of ownership, along with all required membership cards should be submitted when the entries are submitted. If that is not possible, copies must be presented to the show office upon check in.
- 20. Returned checks/Declined Credit Cards: A \$100.00 fee will be assessed to each non negotiable check received by the show. A \$50.00 fee will be assessed for each declined credit card. It is the responsibility of the trainer to provide valid credit cards when making the entries. If management must avail itself of the remedies available under the USEF Rules an additional \$100.00 penalty will be assessed for a total of \$200.00/\$150.00 (maximum). During the show an open check or credit card must be on file in the show office for any additions/changes made during the show. Accounts will be closed out following the show and receipts emailed to the trainer.
- 21. Safe Sport Requirements: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org
