She was the first instructor to train a Morgan Triple Crown Champion Saddle Seat Equitation rider (UPHA Challenge Cup, AMHA Gold Medal and World Champion Saddle Seat Equitation) and she did this two years in a row. Over 150 World Champion horses and riders adorn her accomplishments and she has been a USEF Morgan R Judge for over 25 years, with assignments that have included four Morgan Grand Nationals, 11 USEF Saddle Seat Equitation Finals at the American Royal, and many World Cup Trials. She coached the winning "Team Morgan" riders against the South Africans in 2009 and judged the World Cup Saddle Seat Equitation Finals in South Africa in 2006.
